
Dear Mr. Hussein:

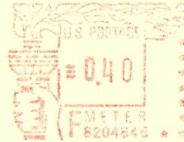
